

"Undoing Racism"® and Anti-Racism Organizing

"Undoing Racism"® is a 2 ½- day workshop retreat, instructed by The Peoples Institute for Survival and Beyond, and assisted by members of the Diocesan Anti-Racism Commission. The workshop's systemic approach emphasizes understanding racism, learning from history, developing leadership, maintaining accountability to communities, undoing internalized racial oppression, and understanding the role of organizational gate keeping as a mechanism to perpetuate institutional racism. Spanish/English interpretation is available upon request.

May 11 - 13, 2017 (Thurs PM, Fri and Sat)

(and followup "debriefing" May 20)
Participants must attend the full 2 ½ days to receive certificate of completion. The workshop is a residential retreat. It begins Thursday with group dinner at 6:00 PM followed by training until 9 PM. Friday and Saturday instruction begins after breakfast (provided) at 8:30 AM. The workshop ends on Saturday at approximately 4 PM.
