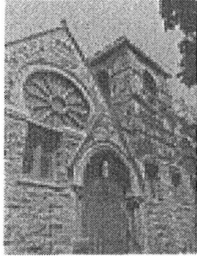
- Our monthly food collection for Starfish Food Pantry is next Sunday. Please remember to bring non-perishable food to donate.

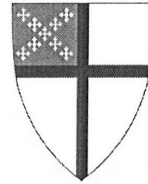

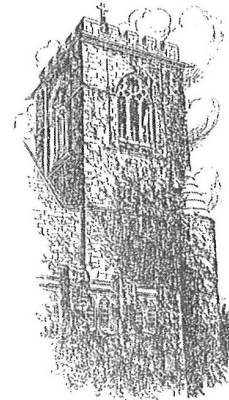
